



The Tagish Community Association is seeking a contractor to undertake the construction of a concrete walkway linking the two entrances to the Community Centre. The walkway will be approximately 7feet wide, 4 inches deep and the length of the building. The project will call for an estimated 10.5 cubic yards of concrete. The ramp entrances to the two doors must be wheelchair accessible. The contractor is responsible for site preparation, construction of footings and the pouring and laying of the concrete to industry standards. Some building materials will be available from the Tagish Community Association. Work must be completed by October 31.
