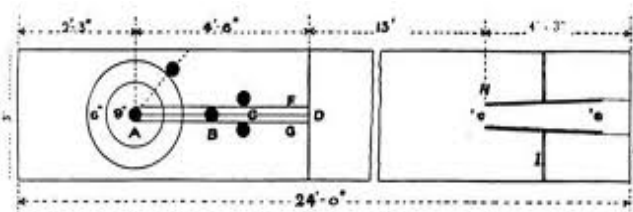

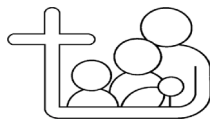

We provide strong input into planning and regulation processes by raising public awareness of specific issues and by providing local and traditional information.

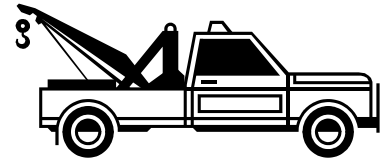

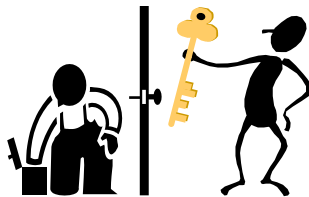

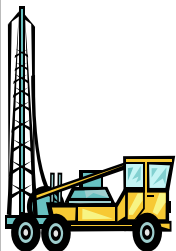
