### 4. Treasurer's Report:

A Balance Statement and Statement of Revenue & Expenses up to July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2013 was provided to Board, prepared jointly by Louise and Shelley. Still working on calculation of GST rebate – Non-profits receive back 50% of gst paid. It appears that the TCA has not been submitting the GST rebate request yearly. Louise and Shelly will continue to work on this. Paul asked if the variance between the budget amount and the Year To Date expenditures for each line item could be shown as a percentage rather than a numerical difference.

## 5. Recreation Director's Report:

Colin presented his first written report for the period of July to August 28<sup>th</sup>, following the format suggested by the Board of Directors. Activities included Coffee & Chat, Pre-School Plays, 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Harvest Fair, a Baseball Game, Music Jam, Carpet Bowling, Pancake Breakfast and a wedding as well as familiarizing himself with the position and the people. Peter recommended continual advertising using the newspaper freebies, etc. Suggestion of setting up an excel sheet keeping records of both attendees and of money received.

Discussed plans for weekly jam sessions, Youth Mountain biking and a Volunteer Appreciation Day – mid Sept. Agreed \$220.00 could be used for pizza for volunteers. Colin will organize it with Cleo. September 14<sup>th</sup> around supper time.

Ideas offered for future events included weekly "Pub Style" starting in October, no alcohol, including ping pong, games, on Fridays. Colin will work with Jane from the Library to organize the Pumpkin Carving and the Hallowe'en Dance.

#### 6. Food Service

Jennifer Daniels is a Nutritionist that is available to come to the TCA and discuss a healthier menue. Colin has received some comments. Louise added that she has

attended workshops that distributed a lot of materials on this topic and that information is in the TCA office.
