4. Tagish Planning Week – Goals and Schedule

Jane reviewed draft schedule of events and topics for Focus Group discussions.

- Focus group discussions to take place at Community Hall. Except for the local business discussion, which may take place at Six Mile resort.
- Coordinating with C/TFN General Council and Adaka Culture festival.

Discussion:

- C/TFN's interests in residential or recreational development on large settlement parcels and the campground. YG has approached C/TFN about joint development potential.
- "Governance" Tagish is just getting its local advisory area established, but the natural next step is to become a municipality.
- 2nd access (to Tagish Estates and Taku subdivision). Access road (Penny Cook Lane) to Six Mile East.
- Question about the need for new subdivision – Tagish Estates still have room for more lots.
- Notice for the property owners – there is not enough time to send out. Rely on posters and emails.
- Paul and Doris to coordinate with Jane to get the word out
