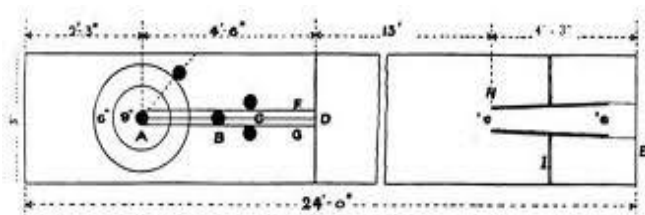


## CARPET BOWLING

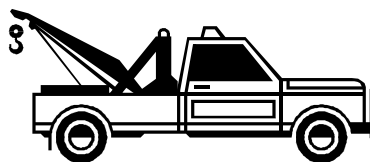

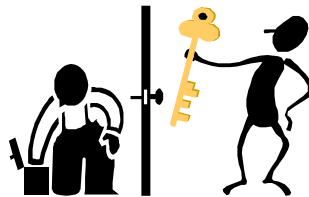

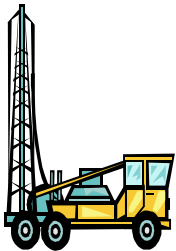
