Rescue attempt earns officer top award

An act of bravery last summer by Yukon RCMP Const. Dan Rouleau was recognized last Thursday with the highest award in the national police force.

Rouleau was presented with the Commission's Commendation for Bravery for diving into the Yukon River and attempting to rescue a teenager who had jumped in to save his dog. First on the scene near the Millennium Trail in Riverdale, Rouleau donned a lifejacket and swam to where he could see a shadow under the surface. He was able to grab Close-Silverfox and bring him to shore. He and Baceda pulled the teenager onto the bank and performed CPR until emergency medical personnel arrived. We would like to extend a warm welcome to Const. Rouleau as a new member of the Tagish/Carcross Community.

cluding a Nordic Walking program.

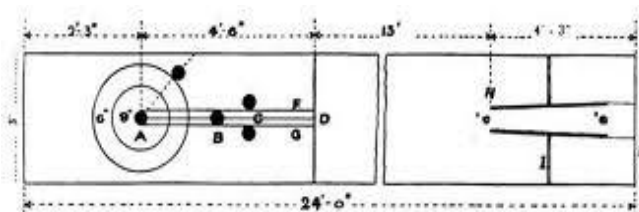
Over the course of the summer, carpet bowling ,

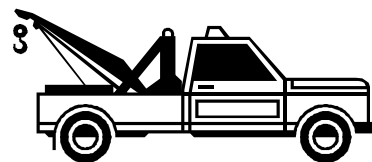

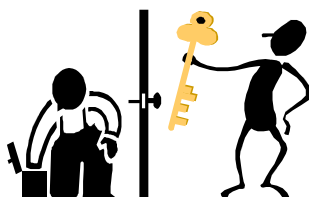

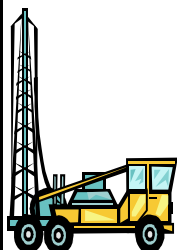
